

DIVORCE OPEN FINALE RULES



Sample Date 2024

Men Please play from the <u>White</u> tees, Ladies and Men 75+ from the <u>Red</u> tees. Each Couple is a 2 person team.

Handicaps are not being used.

Summer Rules: Play the ball as it lies. January 2023 Golf Canada Rules apply.

Holes 1, 2 & 3 - BETTER BALL FORMAT

Each member of a two-person team plays their own ball, so two balls are in play for each team, four balls in each foursome. Record each player's score on the scorecard. Each team counts the lower of its two scores as the "team" score. **Each player must use their score once in the 3 holes.** Maximum score of "Double-Par" on any one hole. Handicaps are not being used.

HOLES 4, 5 & 6 - TWO PERSON TEAM SCRAMBLE

Both players hit a tee shot. The best tee shot is selected and both players hit a second shot from there, within 1 club's length of the same spot, no closer to the hole (same cut of grass). The second shot is then selected, and the procedure continues until one member of the team holes a putt. One team score is recorded for each hole. There is no minimum number of tee shots required from each player. Handicaps will not be used.

Holes 7, 8 & 9 - ALTERNATE SHOT

Each two-person team plays one ball per hole with the players taking turns until each hole is complete. Player's alternate hitting tee shots, with one player teeing off on 7 and 9, and the other on hole 8. Choice is up to each group. One team score is recorded for each hole.

Formats are played on **"the"** holes listed, **NOT "your"** holes. Example: a team that starts the shotgun on the 6th hole would play their first hole in a Scramble, then the next 3 holes Alternate Shot. Every team plays the same format on the same holes.

Closest to the Pin on the green: Ladies #2 | Men #6

Longest Drive in the fairway: Ladies #4 | Men #5
